Holiday shutdown at St. Albert Public Library

ST. ALBERT, AB – Please be advised that St. Albert Public Library will be closed December 24 through January 3, in alignment with the City of St Albert holiday shutdown during the same period. Patrons will have continued access to all eLibrary materials and digital offerings during the shutdown, but staff will not be available to offer remote services.

The Library will resume remote services and Curbside Pickup service on Monday, January 4. The Library's doors will remain closed on January 4 until further notice, pending new direction from the Province of Alberta regarding pandemic restrictions.

Patrons are invited to continue placing hold requests for Curbside Pickup service throughout the holiday shutdown; staff will resume processing those requests when they return to work on January 4.

Library staff encourage St. Albertans to enjoy the many online offerings available during the shutdown. Digital offerings include: eBooks, digital audiobooks, magazines, newspapers, films, TV and music; online courses and eLearning support through the eLibrary; and our growing collection of Online Programs, which includes recorded Library programs and storytimes, Virtual Escape Rooms, Tech Talks, Neighbourhood Nature videos, podcasts and more.
