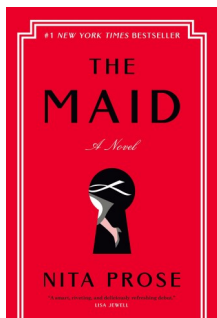

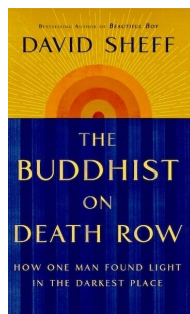

by Nita Prose

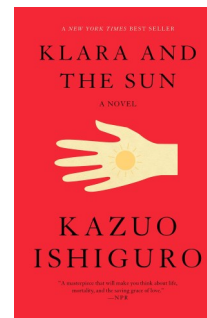
