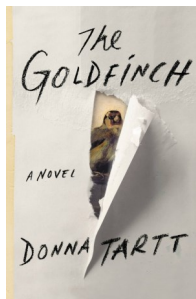

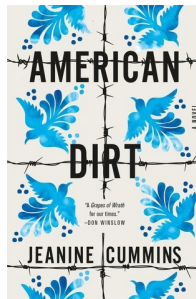

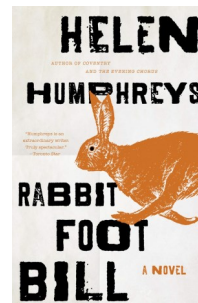
The Goldfinch

Lydia Quixano Pérez runs a bookstore in Acapulco. Forced to flee from the drug cartels, Lydia and eight-year-old Luca are instantly transformed into migrants, riding "la bestia" north toward the United States. This suspenseful page-turner is also a rare exploration into the inner hearts of desperate migrants.
