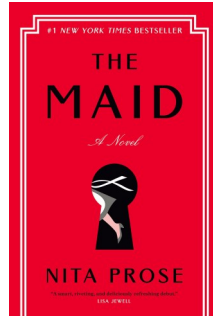

by Elif Shafak

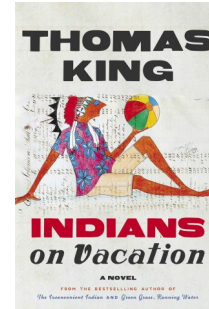
